

Permission to Remain in Housing while a Part-time Student

When students sign their housing contract, they are agreeing to remain a full-time student while living in housing. Although it's counter-intuitive, if a student elects to go to a part-time status, this status does not "kick them out" of the dorms. The reason is because they signed a contract for the academic year and agreed to the terms (staying full-time) by doing so. So, if a student chooses to go to a part-time status, they have to petition to remain in housing because of this status change - going part-time is not a way for people to automatically be released from their housing contract.

A student who has filed paperwork with the College to go to a part-time status needs to also come to the Office of Undergraduate Student Housing to pick up a "Permission to Remain in Housing while Part-Time" form. This form needs to be completed by the student, signed by their RHs, and returned to the Office of Undergraduate Student Housing. It can take up to two (2) weeks for a decision to be communicated to the student.

Permission is typically given for one quarter only. It would be very unusual for a request to be permitted to live in housing while part-time to be approved for consecutive quarters.
