


MOVE-IN 2019 INSTRUCTIONS


The residence hall doors will open at **9:00 AM** for move-in.


GETTING TO GRANVILLE-GROSSMAN FROM LAKE SHORE DRIVE

Exit at **57th Drive** (Museum of Science and Industry)
Continue onto **South Cornell Avenue**, past the first two traffic signals
Veer **right** onto the westbound **Midway Plaisance**
After approximately 1 mile, turn **left** on **South Cottage Grove Avenue**
Turn **left** at the second traffic signal on **60th street**
Join the end of the queue and proceed to the corner of **60th and Ellis**
Follow **unloading instructions** on *page 2*

FROM INDIANA

Take the **I-65 North** or **I-80 West** to the **Skyway (I-90/I-94 W)**
Drive westbound on the Skyway, exiting at **Stony Island Avenue, exit 105**
Drive north on **Stony Island Avenue**, and continue to **Midway Plaisance**
Turn **left** to enter **Midway Plaisance**
After approximately 1 mile, turn **left** on **South Cottage Grove Avenue**
Turn **left** at the second traffic signal on **60th street**
Join the end of the queue and proceed to the corner of **60th and Ellis**
Follow **unloading instructions** on *page 2*





FROM THE DAN RYAN EXPRESSWAY (I-94)

Take **exit 57** to **Garfield Blvd/55th Street**, and drive **east**
Go past **Martin Luther King Jr Drive** and continue onto **Morgan Drive**
Keep driving **right (south)** and continue onto **Payne Drive**
Turn **left** at the uncontrolled intersection
Turn **right** on **Cottage Grove Avenue**
Turn **left** at **60th Street**
Join the end of the queue and proceed to the corner of **60th** and **Ellis**
Follow **unloading instructions** below

UNLOADING

In order to facilitate a smooth and orderly flow into the building, **cars will be lined up** and students will be able to unload in the order in which they arrive. Ellis Avenue will be blocked off between 60th and 61st Streets on move-in day – the only way to enter the street is to wait in the queue of cars on 60th Street. The car line will extend from **60th Street** and may stretch several blocks, but the line will continue to move along to get each car to the nearest drop-off area. In order to avoid running the meter while waiting in line, taxicabs should not wait in the car queue on 60th Street, but instead should be directed to drop off passengers on the corner of 61st Street and Ellis Avenue. Taxicabs coming from the airport should follow the directions above via I-94, but turn from Cottage Grove Avenue onto 61st Street. Proceed **three blocks east** to **Ellis Avenue**, where you can exit the taxicab. Be prepared to share the name of the House where you will be living – there are two drop-off areas and you will be directed to the closest one. Flat-bed carts and large rolling bins will be available to assist you with your move. The House O-Aides will coordinate the carts and bins and can provide one as you unload. Once you arrive at your room, the cart will need to be immediately unloaded and returned to the check-in area.

PARKING

After unloading all your belongings, you will be instructed to immediately move your car to make room for the next arriving student. You should explore the surrounding neighborhood and Midway Plaisance for street parking. Please be patient, as the area can be more crowded than usual due to move-in.
